

Say What You See – Artwork

- 1) Choose one painting/piece of artwork



Look carefully and then think of **5 words** to **describe** the artwork.

Think about what it is made of; what it is showing you; how it makes you feel; whether you like or dislike parts of it; whether it reminds you of anything else.

- 2) Now, you will need to **work in pairs**.

Each of you will **choose a piece of artwork** and **look at it for 60 seconds**.

Then, turn your back to the artwork or **look away**, and **sketch or draw** what you can remember. (Your partner can give you clues if you get stuck.)

Then, **swap with your partner** when they sketch or draw their artwork.

- 3) When you are both finished, look back and compare your sketch/drawing with the original object.


